Jessica Marie Hall '12

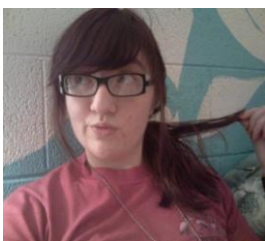
