SCHOLARSHIP

DEMONSTRATION OF TALENT, SKILL, PROMISE

CREATIVE WRITING

- ▶ One-paragraph statement about ambition for creative work
- ▶ PORTFOLIO: **Choose one of the following three options.**
 - Poetry: Three poems
 - Prose (fiction or nonfiction): up to five pages, double spaced
 - Poetry and Prose: One poem and prose (fiction or creative nonfiction), up to four pages, double spaced

DANCE

- ▶ Video submission with solo component
- ▶ One letter of recommendation from dance instructor
- ▶ One-page statement about ambition for creative work

STUDIO ART

- ▶ Required materials for studio art scholarships along with digital portfolio, including 10 images, should be submitted to HUcreativetalent@gmail.com
- ▶ List of all related studies pursued in high school, privately, and in summer programs

THEATRE

You may apply for one of the following three categories.

- ▶ PERFORMANCE
 - Electronic submission of an audition piece and a Skype interview if requested
 - Prepare two contrasting monologues (*approximately two minutes each*)
 - One-page statement about ambition for creative work
 - Students interested in musical theatre should prepare a song
- ▶ TECHNICAL THEATRE AND/OR DESIGN
 - Portfolio of photographs or audiovisual recording
 - One-page statement about ambition for creative work
- ▶ PLAYWRITING OR DRAMATURGY
 - One sample submitted in .doc or .pdf or audiovisual recording
 - One-page statement about ambition for creative work

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Funds are limited and applicants are encouraged to apply early. Awards are available for both music and nonmusic majors. Regardless of major, scholarship recipients must agree to remain involved in the music department each semester through courses, private lessons, and/or participation in ensembles.

MUSIC

- ▶ Virtual audition: Submit a virtual audition that represents your talents
 - Vocal and instrumental submissions are welcomed
 - Personal compositions are also accepted, as Hollins is home to many budding artists in this area
- ▶ Provide a brief statement (500 words or less) addressing the question, “In what ways has music shaped you?”
