Scholarship Information

Four partial scholarships in the amount of \$395 each are available for participants who would not be able to attend such an experience without financial assistance. While we do not ask for specific financial information, we ask applicants to self-certify that without financial assistance it will be difficult, if not impossible, for them to attend. This certification will be taken and accepted at face value.

The awards will be made at the discretion of the scholarship board and are based on both the merit of the work and financial need. Recipients must cover their own travel, lodging, and food.
