Workshop Fee: \$1,000 (\$900 for alumni)

A non-refundable \$100 deposit is due with the registration and required to reserve your spot. \$500 due by April 3; Payment in full due by May 1.

Twenty hours of non-credit instruction is provided. Recertification points may be granted. Check with your supervisor

Arrive to campus on Monday July 10. Check-in between 11 am and 12 noon. Workshop will begin at 1 p.m. Depart campus Friday, July 14 following lunch.

Campus Housing:
